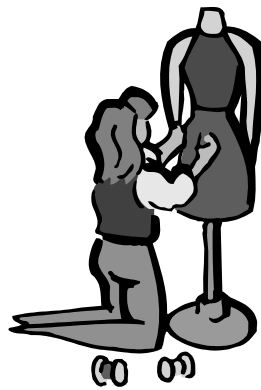

4. Sew a straight line
5. Zig zag a straight line
6. Back tack
7. Neaten threads
8. Zig zag a plain seam
9. Over lock a plain seam
10. Over lock a seam
11. Utility stitches
12. Cushion cover
13. Post test.
