

Write that Essay Online

This year as part of your son or daughter's English studies students will have the opportunity to reinforce their classroom learning by participating in an online curriculum support programme aimed at developing individual writing abilities. Designed by Dr Ian Hunter, Write that Essay Online provides learners with opportunities to progress their writing skills in new and engaging ways. Presented in modules, the programme provides 20 years of educational experience with web-based technology, to advance student writing capability; as students' progress through specific modules, they acquire key writing skills that enable them to confidently and consistently deliver quality written work – in essays and other writing tasks – across their subject disciplines.

Benefits include:

- Reinforcement of material covered in the classroom
- Individual learning experiences, set to student ability
- Opportunities for parental support in the development of writing skills
- Access to materials at any time from any location
- Interactive tools to encourage learners
- Individual modules that provide a logical path to writing mastery

- Compatibility with iPad, tablet, PC and Mac

Student activity on Write that Essay Online will be monitored weekly to gauge progress and where appropriate, additional modules will be offered dependant on student readiness.

Student Log in Instructions for Write that Essay Online

To access Write that Essay Online a student must have paid for a yearly subscription.

Details of a student who has paid are sent to the administrators of Write that Essay Online to add on to their system.

When a student is loaded on to the Write that Essay Online system, an account activation e-mail is sent to a student's school Gmail account.

To access their school Gmail account a student must search for Gmail and then enter the following details:

- to log in, a student enters their surname, followed by their first initial, followed by the extension @stu.otc.school.nz For example: smithj@stu.otc.school.nz
- for a password, a student uses their password given to them by their form teacher at the beginning of the year to access the school network. If a student has already used this password to access the school network and has then changed their password, they use their changed password.

An e-mail from Write that Essay Online should be in their Gmail inbox, giving details as how a student can access the site.
