## HALLS/HOSTELS/COLLEGES/ACCOMODATION

These are applied for at the beginning of term three so students need to be able to choose by then.

There are two parts to the application ----one is done at school and filled in at school---the second part is filled in either online or at a last resort hard copy by the student themselves and sent off. The University/polytechnics then put the two applications together and places the student. As the accommodation is often over prescribed students do not always get their first choice (this is no reflection on the student just that there are too many applying.)
